The Minutes of the Catton Parish Meeting held in Catton Village Hall at 7.00pm Thursday 3rd May 2018.

1. **Present:** The Chairman Cllr G Peel and Cllrs R Morley, R Blanchard, C Merry, B Harrison and the Clerk. Ward Cllr A Strangeway and 1 member of the public.
2. A number of issues were discussed as outlined below:
 - Organisation of the Hogroast fundraiser to be held on the 23rd June from 6.00pm till 11.00pm is well under way. This has been organised by Christine Thompson to raise money to buy defibrillators for both villages, tickets are available from Christine at Merrilthorne Farm, High Catton for £10 in advance of £14 on the day. Alter Ego have been booked as the evening entertainment. Christine also confirmed that Humber Fire & Rescue will match fund whatever is raised.
 - Potholes are a real problem through both villages, even though some have been filled in the repairs did not last long and they are now in a worse state than ever. CM asked AS for his input on the situation, he stated that funding has been cut yet again and ERYC are struggling to maintain the roads. They are simply not doing a good enough job. He will email Paul Berlotti to try and resolve the situation. If nothing is done then the next step would be to contact Greg Knight.
 - Speeding and volume of traffic remains a problem in the villages, this will not be helped by the number of new houses that are being built in the area.
 - Communication with ERYC is poor, it is very difficult to obtain replies to emails and when something is promised it is rarely carried out.
 - There had been suggestions that a defibrillator be placed on the wall of the Village Hall in Low Catton instead of inside the telephone box.

As there was nothing further to discuss the meeting was closed at 7.30pm.
